TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

NOTICE IS GIVEN that after consultation with Worcestershire County Council and West Mercia Constabulary, Wyre Forest District Council made an Order on **17th July 2019** under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 with the following effect.

On **Saturday 7th September 2019** from time to time between **12.30 and 15.00** the following streets will be closed to all vehicular traffic, including pedal cycles, other than to vehicles participating in the event with the express consent of the organisers:

Areley Common	from entrance to Areley Kings Recreation Ground to Dunley Road (both directions)
Dunley Road	from Areley Common to Bridge Street (both directions)
High Street	from Bridge Street to Vale Road (one way street)
Vale Road	from High Street to Worcester Street (one way street)
Worcester Street	from Vale Road to Bewdley Road (both directions)
Bewdley Road	from Worcester Street to Lombard Street (one way street)
Lombard Street	from Bewdley Road to High Street (one way street)
High Street	from Lombard Street to Lion Hill (one way street)
Lion Hill	from High Street to York Street (one way street)
York Street	from Lion Hill to New Street (one way street)
New Street	from York Street to Moorhall Lane (both directions)
Moorhall Lane	from New Street to Riverside Meadow (both directions)
Martin's Way	from New Street to Car Parks (both directions)

any person committing a breach of the terms of the said Order will be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £1,000.
