Title of Document: Wyre Forest District Local Plan (2016- 2036) – Submission version (Jan 2020)

Subject Matter: The Wyre Forest Local Plan (2016 – 2036) sets out how and where development will take place in the administrative area of Wyre Forest District (“the District”) and guides future planning decisions up to 2036. The Local Plan, when adopted, will form part of the development plan for the District.

Area Covered: Whole of the administrative area of the Wyre Forest District.
