Thank you for giving the SWCs the opportunity to comment on the 10 technical appendices that complement Wyre Forest District Council's statement on Matter 11 of the Examination of the Wyre Forest Local Plan.

For your information Malvern Hills District Council, together with Worcester City Council and Wychavon District Council all adopted the South Worcestershire Development Plan (SWDP) in February 2016 and the SWDP Review Regulation 19 consultation is scheduled for October 2021. Both Malvern Hills and Wychavon Districts have a common administrative boundary with Wyre Forest and as such we are grateful to be given the opportunity to make representations under the Duty to cooperate requirements.
