 - c) application of a `buffer' to make an allowance for under-delivery
 - d) justification for a windfall allowance, including the breakdown by site-size of historic windfalls
 - e) potential contribution to the Class C3 supply from completion of Class C2 accommodation
- 2. Justification for the housing trajectory, taking account of the expected rate of completions and the need to make up the shortfall in the early part of the Plan period
- 3. Prospects for maintaining a rolling 5-year land supply
