Here is our response to the council's statement on new evidence regarding transport issues on matter 11 of the examination of the local plan for Wyre Forest.

OCAG Local Plans Group believes that there are fundamental flaws in WFDC's Revised Plans.

We are concerned that there appears to be a distinct possibility that Traffic Modelling has been based on data several years old rather than more recent, immediately Pre-Covid. Data.

However, our more fundamental concern is that, by refusing to move to the 2018 Housing Figure Projection which means considerably fewer properties needing to be built each year and therefore considerably fewer areas needing to be taken out of the Green Belt, WFDC has produced a plan which, in terms of housing developments needed and thus consequential traffic movements envisaged; is fundamentally flawed.
