- 5. Justification for the proposed changes to the Green Belt boundary, implications for its long-term permanence, provision for compensatory improvements
- 6. Soundness of the Plan's housing and employment land requirements, including their deliverability through the spatial strategy
- 7. Role of Neighbourhood Plans in meeting housing needs
