In accordance with Regulation 19 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004 as amended by The Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England)(Amendment) Regulations 2008 this statement gives notice that Churchfields Masterplan Supplementary Planning Document was formally adopted by Wyre Forest District Council on 28<sup>th</sup> September 2011.

The Churchfields Masterplan SPD forms part of the Local Development Framework and provides an evidence base to inform the development of the Kidderminster Central Area Action Plan. It also sets out a detailed design framework that will guide new development in the area and help determine future planning applications.
