Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan Adoption Statement

The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012

In accordance with Regulation 26 of The Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012, notice is hereby given that the Wyre Forest District Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan was adopted on 25th July 2013.

- Title:** Wyre Forest District Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan
- Subject Matter:** The Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan sets out detailed development management policies to guide the determination of planning applications. It allocates specific sites for particular types of development and provides policies to guide the implementation of this development.
- Inspection:** A copy of the Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan, together with the Sustainability Appraisal Report, the Adopted Policies Map, the Inspector's Report and the submission documents can be viewed on the District Council's web-site: www.wyreforestdc.gov.uk. Copies are also available for inspection at the Worcestershire Hub, Kidderminster and Kidderminster, Stourport-on-Severn and Bewdley libraries during their normal opening hours.
- Challenge:** Any person aggrieved by the Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan may make an application to the High Court under Section 113 of the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 on the grounds that:
- (a) the document is not within the appropriate power;
 - (b) a procedural requirement has not been complied with.
- An application must be made promptly, and in any event, no later than the end of the period of six weeks of the date of the adoption of the Site Allocations and Policies Local Plan, i.e. by 5th September 2013.
